<p>In order to effectively implement the Provincial Sport Development Policy Framework, the Department in conjunction with the Sport Adjudication Panel hereby calls on the Sport and Recreation Federations, Sports Councils, NGOs, CBOs, clubs and individuals to submit proposals for projects that clearly demonstrates the following criteria via all hubs inter-alia:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensuring that implementation of recreational sport development programmes in the hubs compliments the overall Provincial Sport Development Policy Framework. • Mainstreaming meaningful inclusion, in terms of access to services and opportunities, of marginalized groups such as women, youth and people with disabilities. • Promoting the development of young sporting talent from entry level by providing opportunities for talent spotting through to high performance or professional level. • Promoting and supporting sport development initiatives within various communities across Gauteng. 	<p>The Department of Sport, Arts, Culture and Recreation is calling upon all organisations to apply for HIV/AIDS funding for projects in Arts and Culture or Sport and Recreation.</p> <p>In order to be considered, proposals must be in line with the Gauteng AIDS Strategy and demonstrate how they can contribute to one or more of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Promoting positive living through exercise for People Living with HIV and Aids. • Educating sport participants, personalities and arts practitioners and encouraging them to be ambassadors for HIV and AIDS. • Developing HIV and AIDS visual arts, drama or dance works that are integrated into our Mass Participation Hubs. 	<p>The Creative Industries Strategy aims to develop the creative industries and to increase their contribution to the economy, community development and urban regeneration. The Gauteng Arts and Culture Council invites all Arts and Culture Organisations to submit proposals for projects.</p> <p>In order to be considered proposals must demonstrate how they:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Invest in either the development of cultural workers and artists, groups of cultural organisations and enterprises as well as individual creative enterprises that constitutes them. • Develop and promote the products and services of creative clusters and enterprises. • Invest in, support and develop arts and culture activities , events and programming in specific communities.

- Registration Certificate
- Audited Financial Statements (Not more than 1 year old),
- Signed and dated Constitution/ Articles and Memorandum of Association/ Trust Deed,
- Original Tax Clearance Certificate or a Certified copy of a Tax Exemption letter,
- Certified copy of ID,
- Original or certified copies of the last 3 months bank statements
- Costed Project Implementation plan.

Only Gauteng based organisation may apply and projects must be implemented in Gauteng. No faxed or e-mail copies will be allowed. Incomplete and/or late applications will not be processed. All required documentation must be attached to the application form. Previous Applicants must have submitted all outstanding Progress Reports on any grants previously received from the Department of Sport, Arts, Culture and Recreation.
